

## POLICIES

### **I. Hosting**

The CVAC Executive will determine hosts for conference, regional and provincial competition for Senior activities based on the needs established by SHSAA. Consideration will be given to suitability of facilities and to rotating such hosting throughout the Conference.

At the Junior level, the Executive will endeavor to rotate the event throughout the Conference.

### **II. Officials**

Senior Conference / Regional, and Provincial officials will be assigned by the sport referee-in-chief. Payment will be made by the SHSAA.

At the Junior level, the host is to arrange officials for all round-robin and conference playoffs. Following submission of the necessary documentation (Invoice for Officiating Extra Curricular Activities) to the CVAC Extracurricular Facilitator, reimbursement will be made according to the current fee structure.

The sport referee-in-chief or the CVAC Extracurricular Facilitator will assign officials to all Division Championships at the Junior level.

Payment will be made by the CVAC Extracurricular Facilitator, at the SHSAA level, following the submission of the necessary documentation (to the CVAC Extracurricular Facilitator.)

There is no payment for minor officials in volleyball and basketball prior to the finals.

### **III. Affiliated Schools' District Fees**

The affiliated schools within the boundaries of CVAC are RJC, Chief Mistawasis, Mistawasis Nehiyawak High School, Prairie Christian Academy, Ecole Providence and Constable Robin Cameron Education Complex.

At the Senior level, schools pay a district fee (\$25) per registered team.

At the Junior level, affiliated schools are assessed a district fee based on the number of teams registered and the calculated costs of operating each sport. The fee for the upcoming year will be determined by the CVAC Extracurricular Facilitator in August based upon the expenses from the previous year.

All fees are to be submitted by mid-October in order to be eligible to compete in CVAC playoffs.

#### **IV. SHSAA Awards**

The SHSAA annually sponsors district awards that include a Service Award, a Female Coach Award, a Male Coach Award, and an Official's Award. The CVAC Executive will call for nominations for these awards in February/March. Nominations brought forward are narrowed to a maximum of three per heading by the Executive. The recipient decision is made at the spring Athletic Directors' meeting by majority vote.

#### **V. Sport Specific Awards**

CVAC championship medals will be awarded to individual and team champions in the following activities:

- Badminton.....Singles ( Boys and Girls ), Doubles ( Boys and Girls ) and Mixed in Junior and Senior
- Basketball .....Team members in Junior Boys and Junior Girls
- Cross Country ....Age champions for Boys and Girls
- Curling ..... Team members in Senior and Junior Boys, Senior and Junior Girls, and Senior and Junior Mixed
- Golf .....Junior Boys and Junior Girls champion, Junior Team champions, Senior Boys and Senior Girls champions, and Senior Team champions.
- Soccer.....Team members in Junior Boys and Junior Girls
- Track..... Age class champions at the Conference and District levels in Boys and Girls
- Volleyball .... Team members in Junior Boys and Junior Girls

Plaques are provided to the school champions in Junior Soccer, Basketball. and Volleyball, and Track (multiple headings)

Ribbons are provided to the top 8 finishers in each event in Track
